The Regional District of Mount Waddington **bills for utilities only**.

Utilities (water, sewer, garbage, recycling) services varies between communities within the RDMW.

Annual invoices are mailed out before April 1st each year.

PROPERTY TAXES:

When you own property in a rural area, you will receive your property tax notice from the province's Surveyor of Taxes office every June. You pay your property taxes to the province.
